Memorial Crosses at “The Point” in Freehold Borough

The Reynold's detachment has had a long history of service to the Elk's Point Memorial Court of Honor providing maintenance to the crosses, flags and lighting at “the point” in Freehold of the intersection of Route 537 (Main St) and Route 79.

Each cross represents a serviceman who was killed in action and lived in the Freehold Regional School District.

We partnered with Freehold Borough in the renovation of the Elk's Point Memorial Park in 2013 and the World War II Memorial in 2014.

United States Marine Corps Reserve Support

Our local USMC Reserve unit is located in Red Bank, NJ. We provide phone cards for deployed troops, participate in homecoming and going away celebrations and assist individual Marines as the need arises.
